- If there is a tie, we will include students' 5<sup>th</sup> grade final grades in the average. We will follow this process until we can break the tie.

# Academics & Attendance:

All students are required to maintain good attendance (95% or higher), demonstrate responsibility, have passing grades of "C" or better in all subjects and show good behavior. A student who exhibits unsatisfactory conduct in class as reflected in quarterly grade reports or who has misconducts and/or failing to follow reasonable directions in class/school will be ineligible to participate.

# Behavior:

Discipline issues will cause your child not to be a part of a monthly activity. Parents will be notified immediately once an infraction occurs. Should your child receive a Detention or In-School Suspension (ISS) in a particular month, s/he will not be permitted to participate in that month's activity. Should your child receive an Out-of-School Suspension or any acts of violence towards a classmate, teachers, or school personnel, s/he will be ineligible to participate in the out-of-state Class Field Trip, Luncheon, or The Graduation Ceremony.

Funds will not be refunded. All funds paid will be applied to the next month's activity.
