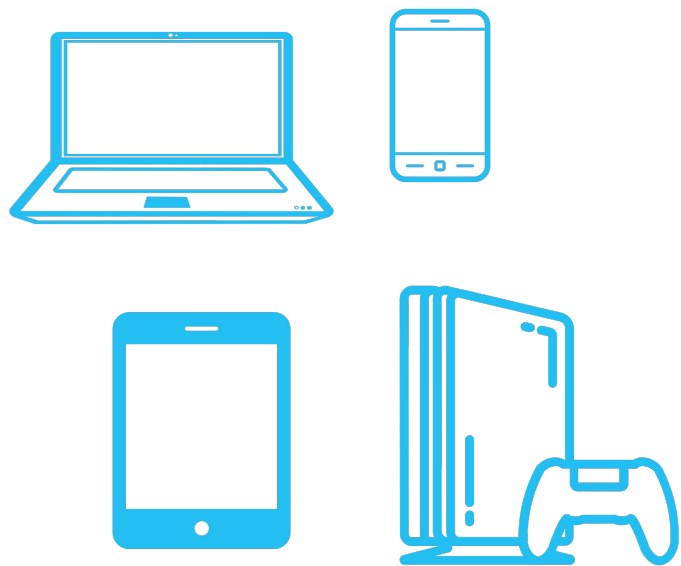
# Google Classroom

- » Gaming Device

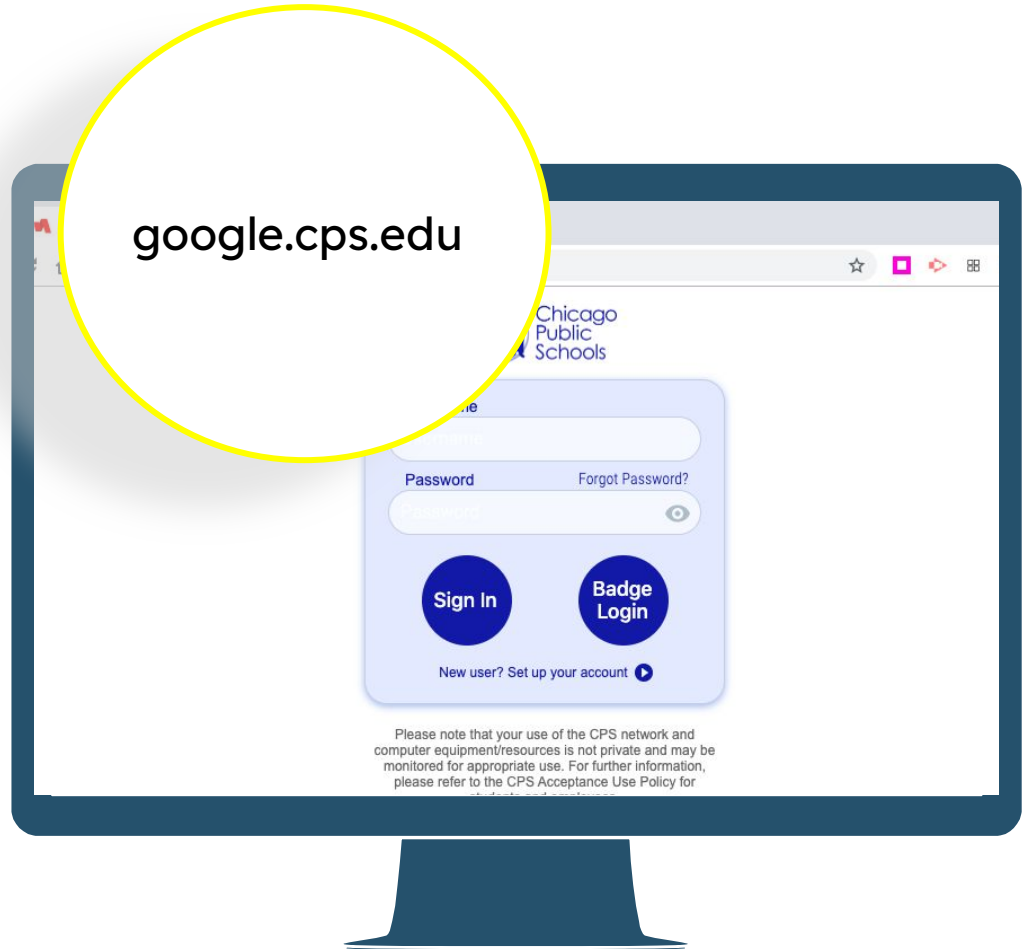
# Accessing Google Classroom

To access Google Classroom, you will need your child's CPS username and password.

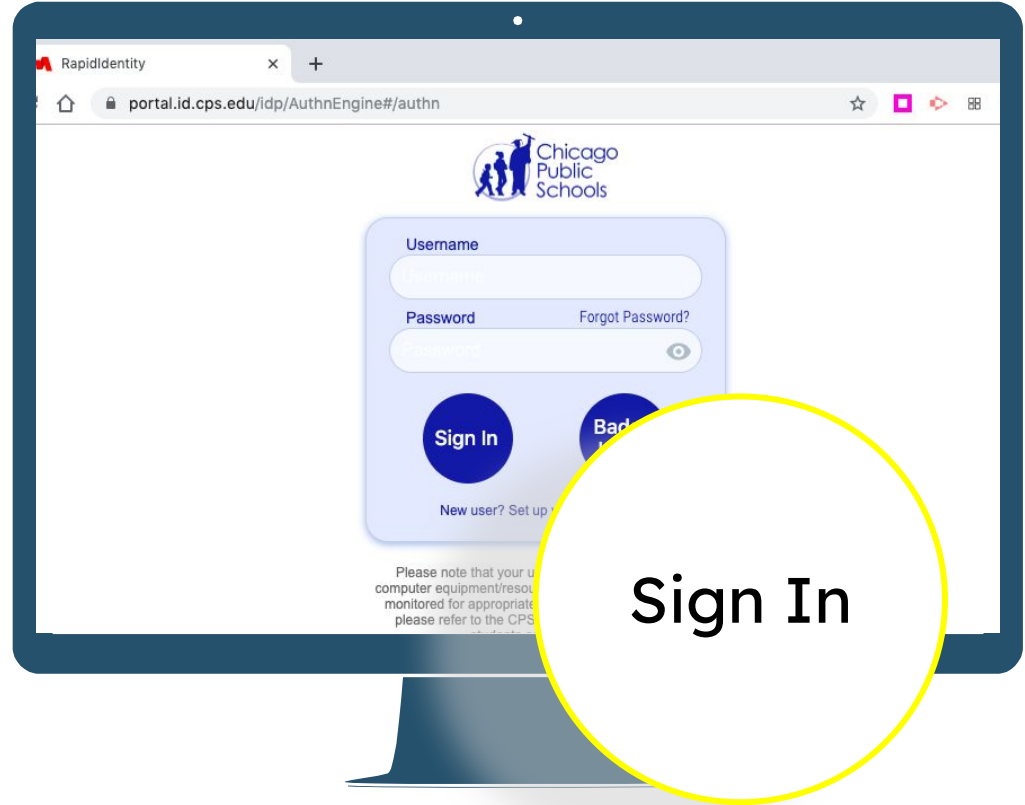
If you do not know the username and password, contact your child's teacher.

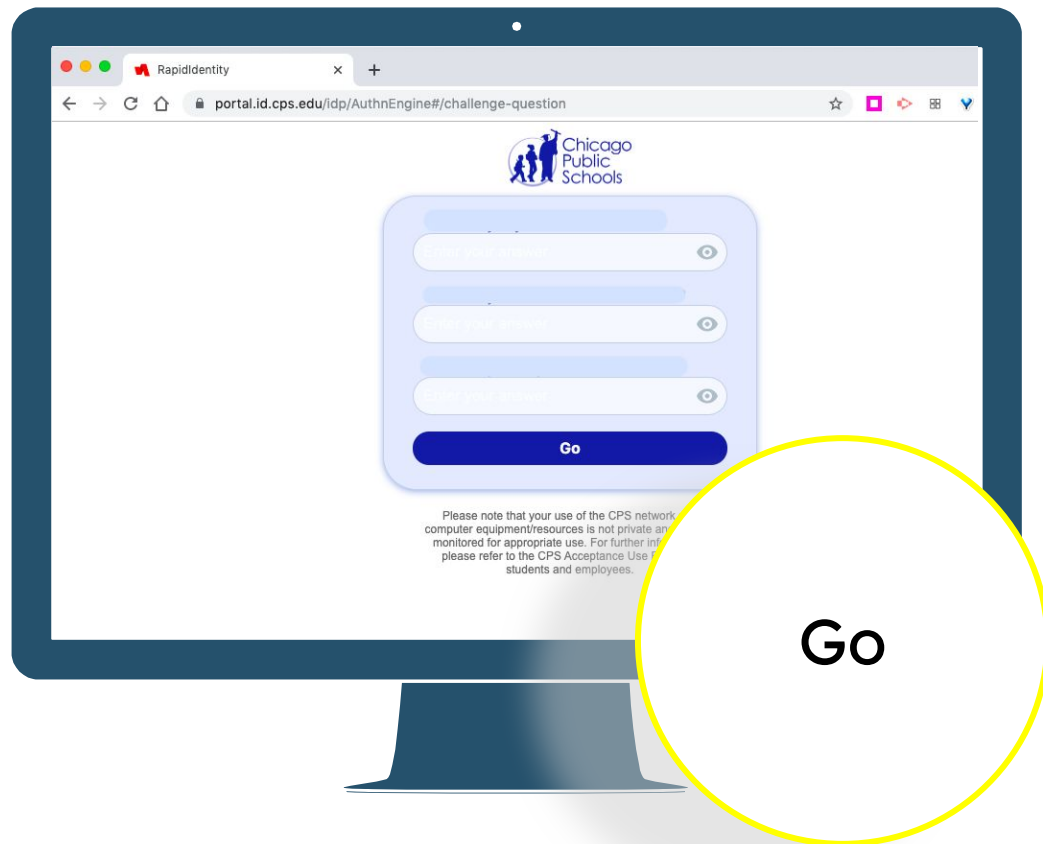

**Click “Sign In”**



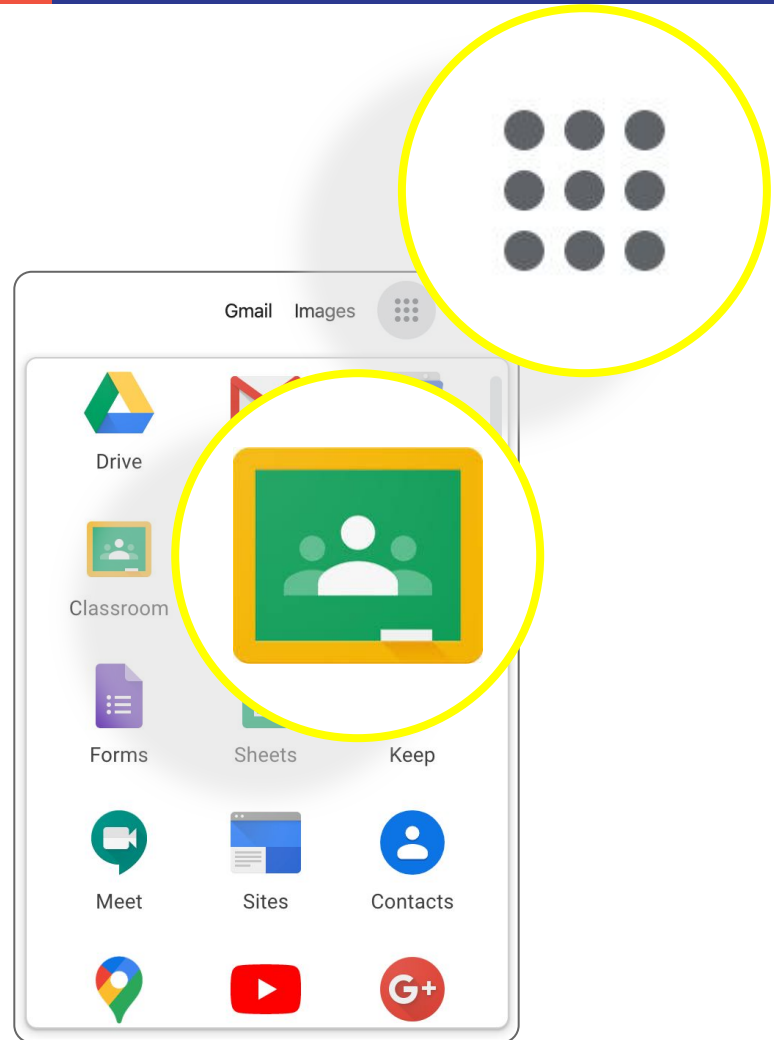

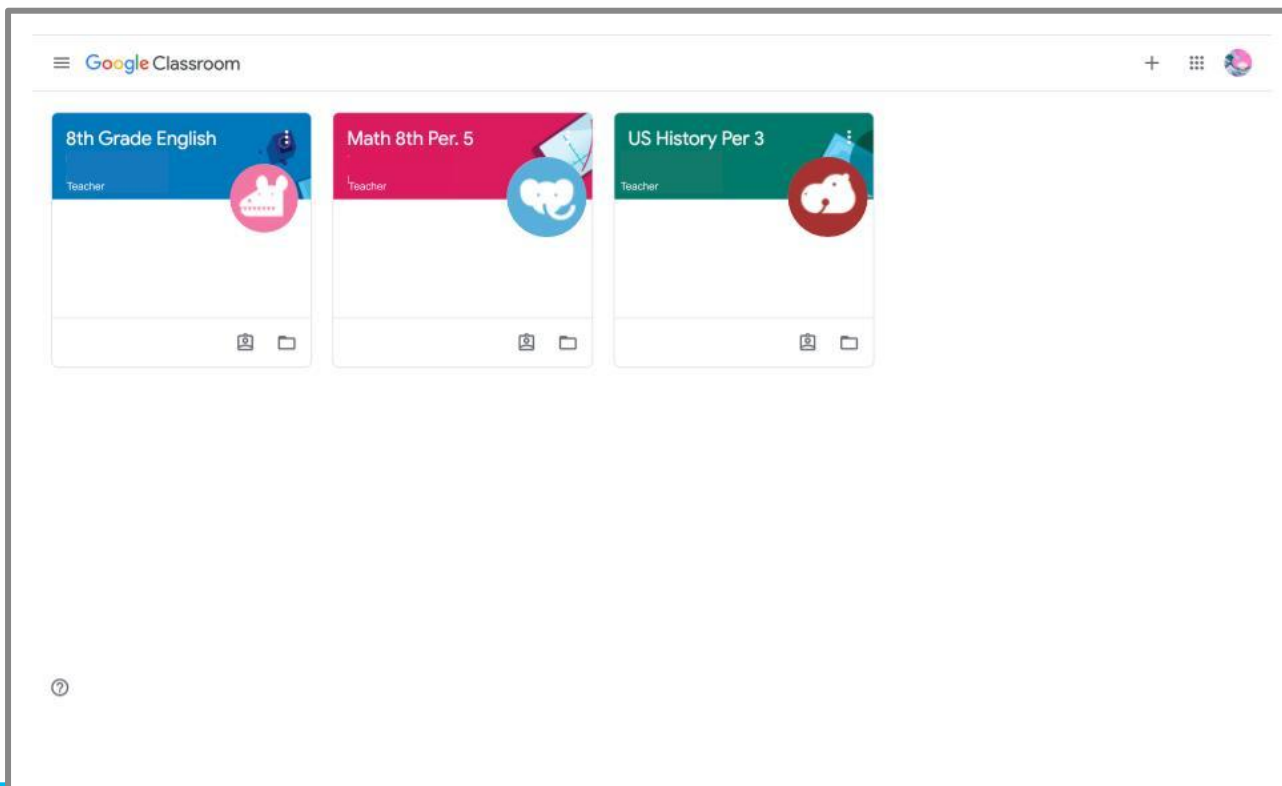

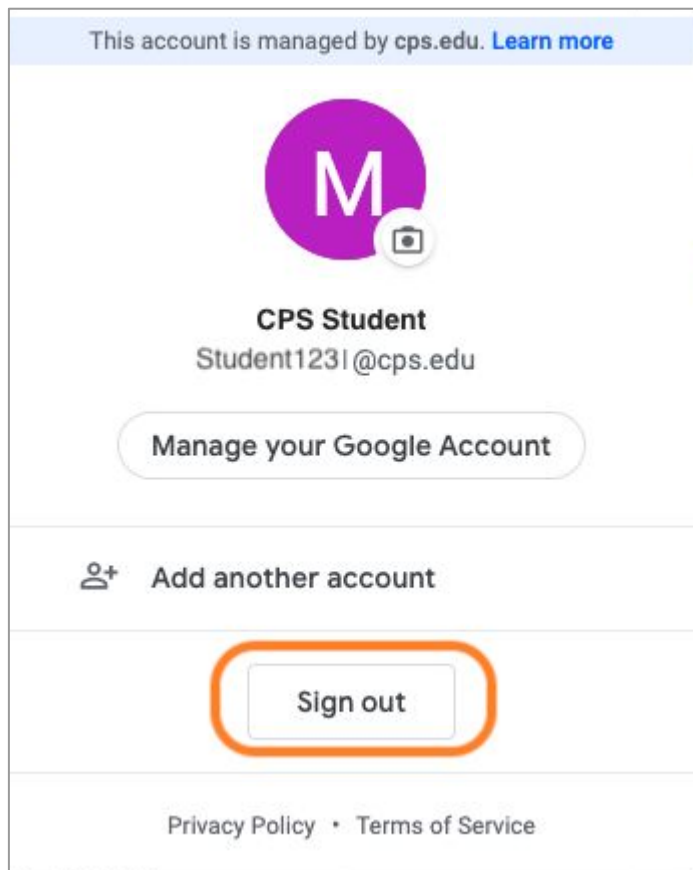
**Click the Google
